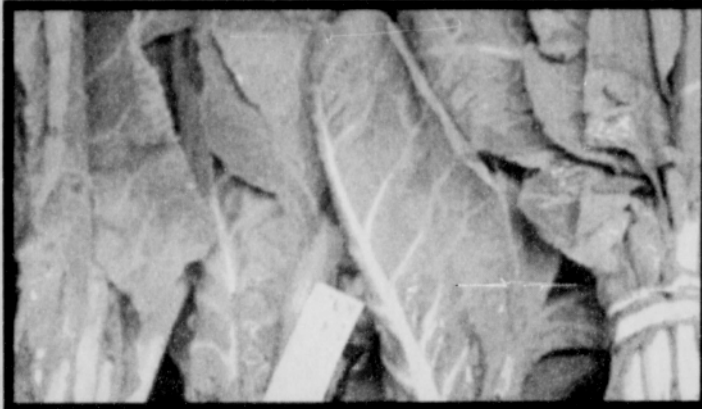

The book starts with the job search process and continues on through relocating and the first days on the job. Its major sections are on surviving office politics and learning professional etiquette and grooming.

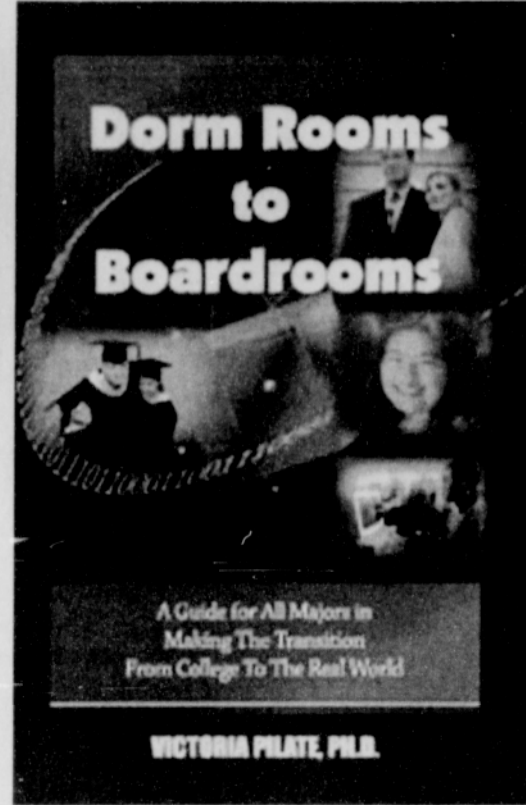
The book covers all major hurdles of starting a job and making career decisions with valuable tips on travel and business presentations.
