
The City of Portland proposes to amend its Consolidated Plan Action Plan FY 2006-07 as follows:

A. Insert the following narrative on the use of BEDI/108 Financing Tools to page 50:

On behalf of the Siltronic Corporation, the City successfully applied in FY 2004-05 for a \$2,000,000 Brownfield Economic Development Initiative (BEDI) award in conjunction with a \$26,000,000 Section 108 loan guarantee. The Corporation has since decided to undertake its expansion overseas. The City intends to submit a revised application to the Department of Housing and Urban Development for the \$2 million BEDI grant and a \$26 million HUD Section 108 Loan Guarantee. The revised application will seek authority to provide belowmarket-rate loans to projects that create significant employment opportunities or provide significant public benefits on perceived or actual brownfield sites.

The City plans to use the funds for two potential projects that together would use approximately \$12.5 million, are for Oregon Steel Mills and U.S. Barge. The City anticipates that each would create between 110 and 125 new jobs on industrial lands perceived to be contaminated. The is also considering a \$10 million loan to a public-private facility charged with developing and promoting all aspects of this region's manufacturing and engineering growth. Finally, the City intends to seek authority to place \$5.5 million in an industrial loan fund for belowmarket-rate loans to projects that create significant employment opportunities or provide significant public benefits on perceived or actual brownfield sites.
