Pioneering Astronaut Helps Promote Technology Fields

First woman of color in space leads by example

Pioneering astronaut Dr. Mae C. Jemison has launched a project to promote aerospace opportunities and salute women of color in flight from around the world.

Her aim is to redefine the face of aerospace and aviation and open these science and technology fields for all students.

Jemison, the first woman of color in the world to go into space, hosted the "Reality Leads Fantasy—Celebrating Women of Color in Flight" symposium last month in Chicago, sponsored by the Dorothy Jemison Foundation for Excellence.

The purpose was to highlight the incredible roles women of color from around the world have and continue to play in pushing the envelope of altitude, human endurance, speed, air transportation and space exploration; as well as
