## Civil Rights Activist Dies

### Patricia Davis-Ellis

Patricia Davis-Ellis died Jan. 12, 2007. She was born Aug. 24, 1946 in Birmingham, Ala., the third child of Norman and Annie Catherine Wooding.



She confessed Christ at an early age and joined St. John Baptist Church under the leadership of Rev. J.C. Crosby. She was very active in church and started singing in the youth choir at an early age.

She was active in the Civil Rights Movement, joining her sister Sandra in Washington D.C. for Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr.'s famous speech "I Have a Dream" in 1963. After the march on Washington, they attended the march from Selma, Ala. to Montgomery, Ala. Both went to jail, walked the picket lines, were sprayed with a fire hose, and played significant roles in getting African Americans registered to vote and casting ballots.

She met Joseph Davis and was married in 1966, and to that union two beautiful daughters were born: Victoria (Vickie) and Nedra in Portland, Ore. They attended St. Mark Baptist Church where she was ac-

tive in the choir and mission department, under the leadership of the late Rev. Wilder. In the early 1990s she united with New Hope Baptist Church under the leadership of Rev. Robert C. Jointer, then joined Fellowship Baptist Church under the leadership of Rev. Johnny Pack IV, where she served faithfully until her death.

She was always giving, running errands, cooking and taking care of everyone. She never could say no to anyone. She will truly be missed by all the lives that she touched.

She was preceded in death by her mother and a sister, Brenda Wooding Jackson.

She leaves to cherish her memories her father; two daughters; three grandsons, Antonio Edward Davis, Teon Trae' Davis, and Almari Sims; stepchildren, Aubrey (Shari) Davis, Reginald (Mattie) Davis, Brenda (Glenn) Derritt, Nathan Davis and Courtney Davis; brother Norman (Vanessa) Wooding III; four sisters, Melody Wooding of Seattle, Sandra (Vern) Eastland of Vancouver, Wash., Karon (Larry) Witt of Birmingham, Ala., and Charita (Mandria) Rowser of Loganville Ga.; a dear friend Randy Miller; and many other family members and friends.
