

Sound Tech Gets **Record Oscar Nod** Got his break from Sidney Poitier

Willie Burton, an African American sound technician in the film industry, was honored with his seventh Academy Award nomination for sound mixing the critically acclaimed theatrical musical, "Dreamgirls."

The honor gives Burton the title of have the most Oscar nominations for an African American. The only person who comes close to his record is Denzel Washington, who has five.

Burton has mixed more than 77 films since 1970, and was honored in 2005 with the Lifetime Career Achievement Award by the Cinema Audio Society.

He was born in Tuscaloosa, Ala. with extremely humble beginnings of picking cotton just to help buy school clothes and a decent pair of shoes. He attended trade school for Electronics before joining the Navy and working in engineering.

Burton was a janitor in an office building before getting his big break to do sound mixing for a movie called, "Let's Do It Again" (1975). Sidney Poitier, a star actor in the film, was the man who made it happen.

"Poitier took a chance on me when no one else would," Burton recalls. "But he looked me in the eyes and said 'you better not let me down." Afterwards, Burton and Poitier developed a bond, and Poitier hired him to do sound for all of his subsequent films.
