

'Show Me the Body'

The Northwest Film Center Presents Reel Blues - two special outdoor screenings taking place Thursday, July 5 and Friday, July 6 during the Waterfront Blues Festival.

On Thursday Reel Blues presents "Johnny Otis Reunion," a 1970 film about bandleader Johnny Otis and old friends, who gather for a one-night-only salute to the glory days of the Central Avenue R&B scene in Los Angeles during the 1940s and '50s (60 minutes).

On Friday attend a screening of "Hendrix and the Blues," a 2003 film featuring timeless Jimi Hendrix live performances and other blues classics (25 minutes). Following will be "The Losers' Club," a 2004 film featuring Portland guitarists and bandleaders Jim Mesi and Steve Bradley, both legends in the 1970's Portland music scene. (50 minutes).

Show times are 10 p.m. for both nights and are free with festival admission.
