

Summer Shows Rock the Zoo



Los Lobos translates to "the Wolves," which is appropriate for their Wednesday, July 25 appearance at the Oregon Zoo.

Featured performances Patty Griffin, Los Lobos

As mid-summer approaches, the Oregon Zoo concert series only gets hotter with performances this week by folk and rock favorite Patty Griffin and the East Los Angeles legends Los Lobos.

When Patty Griffin sings, you don't so much hear it as feel it in your soul. The twice Grammy-nominated singer/songwriter performs at the Oregon Zoo, Friday, July 20 at 7 p.m., as part of the Wells Fargo Summer Concert Series presented by Fred Meyer.

Griffin, whose sound is difficult to categorize, moves from acoustic folk to all-out rock to include the classic R&B and gospel music

that have long been a source of inspiration for her. Griffin continues to hone her craft and win larger and larger audiences with her latest album, "Children Running Through."

Los Lobos, Spanish for "The Wolves," prove they know the secret to survival.

The East Los Angeles rockers have come back more than two decades after their debut album. They are alive and well and still producing inventive and passionate rock music. The group performs at the Oregon Zoo on Wednesday, July 25 at 7 p.m.

Los Lobos draw their sound from a combination of blues, rockabilly, jazz and Latin music, filtering it through their Mexican-American

heritage. Even after more than 30 years together, the three-time Grammy winners continue to expand and refine their sound, and their more eclectic albums have won them the most critical praise and recognition.

Currently the group is on tour for their most recent release, "The Town and the City," described by Rolling Stone magazine as magical.

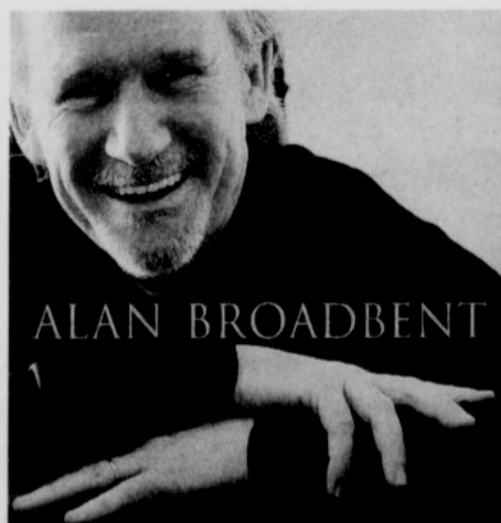

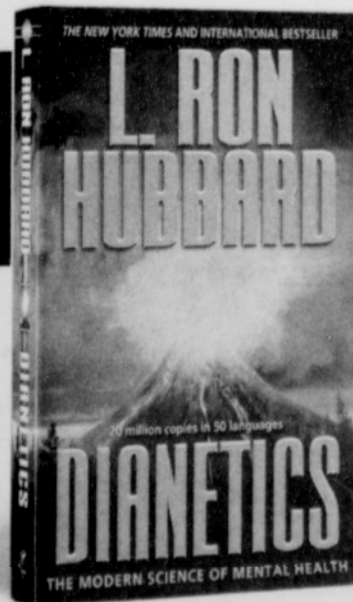
