Partial Victory for Knicks Coach

Found guilty but no fine

(AP) - A jury decided Tuesday that New York Knicks coach Isiah Thomas sexually harassed a former team executive, subjecting her to unwanted advances and a barrage of verbal insults, but also said he does not have to pay punitive damages.

After an ugly, three-week trial, the verdict gives Thomas a partial victory in the lawsuit filed by Anucha Browne Sand-

The jury did find that Madison Square Garden committed harassment against Browne Sanders, and decided that she is entitled to \$11.6 million in damages.

U.S. District Judge Gerard Isiah Thomas E. Lynch called it an "eminently reasonable" verdict before Thomas announced his intention to appeal.

> The harassment verdict was widely expected after the jury sent a note to the judge Monday indicating that it believed Thomas and the other defendants, Madison Square Garden and MSG chairman James Dolan, sexually harassed Browne Sanders, a married mother of three.
