Irvington Spiritual Conference

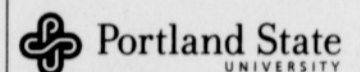
The Irvington Covenant Church, 4046 N.E. Martin Luther King Blvd., invites worshipers dressed in military costume to declare war against
