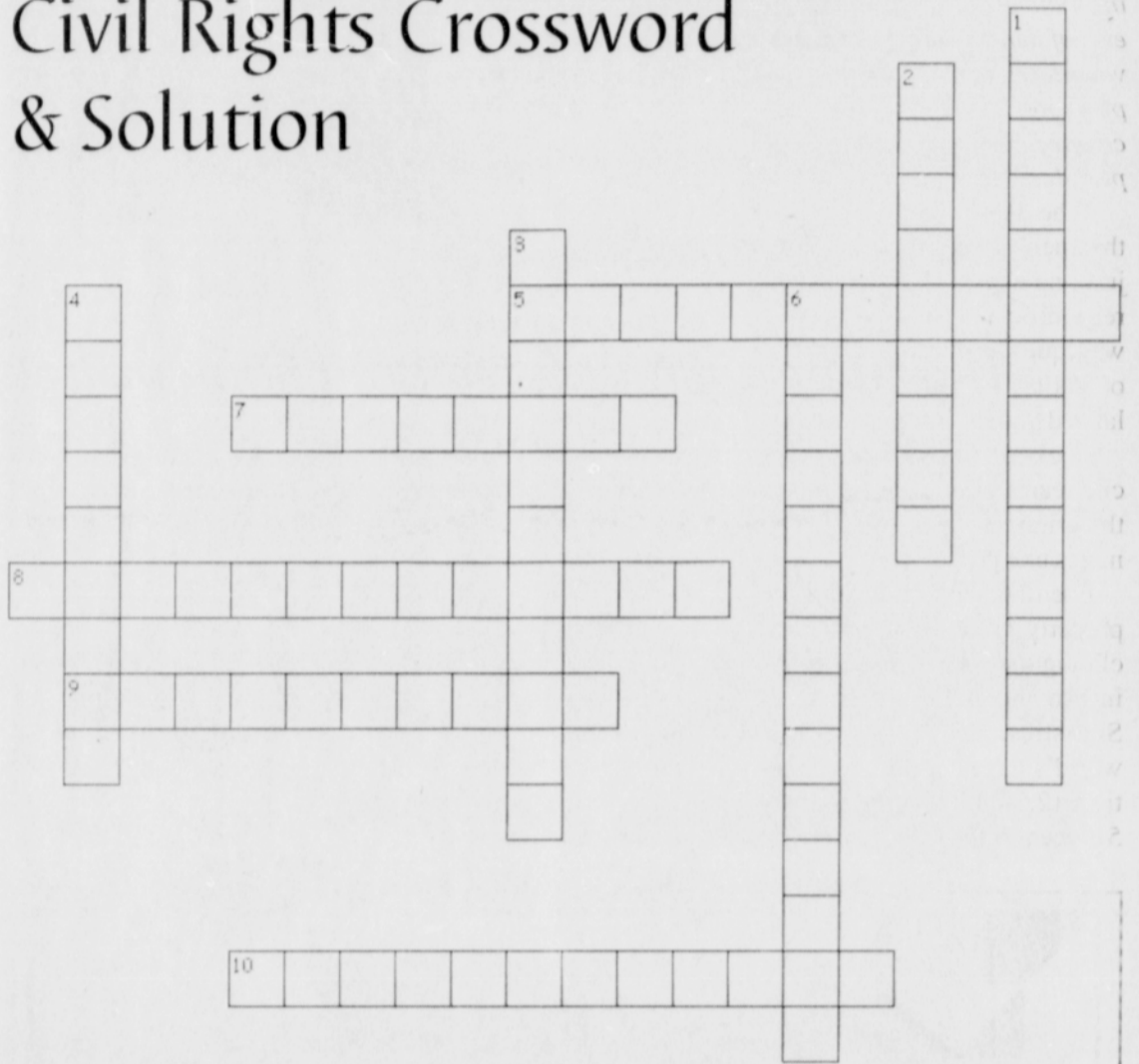
Majors" for civil rights.
