While some say wagons are a dying breed, having largely been ditched in the U.S. in favor of SUVs and crossovers, it's unfortunate because, as evidenced by the redesigned Volvo V70, there are plenty of compelling reasons to consider one. This Volvo offers a comfortable ride, upscale interior, a number of safety features and a large cargo area.

Volvo's hallmark has been and remains safety, and the V70 is available with advanced safety features like Collision Warning with Brake Support. This system uses a light and sound to warn the driver if it senses a collision may occur with a car in front of it; the system brakes the car if the driver doesn't heed the alert.

More impressively, the V70's options include a rear-seat entertainment system with two 7-inch headrest-mounted displays. It is rare to see seatback-mounted screens even on luxury vehicles, and their availability on the V70 shows that Volvo is aiming at the higher end of the market with its third-generation model. An auxiliary video input jack also allows connection of video games or external DVD players.

Another notable--if gimmicky-tech highlight on the V70 is the Personal Car Communicator which uses two-way radio technology and a heartbeat detector to notify the driver if there is anyone in the car while the alarm is activated. What I found more useful is the Keyless Drive system, which lets drivers unlock the car and start the engine without removing the key fob from their pockets.

The V70 is a comfortable and capable long-haul cruiser that takes Volvo's traditional safety focus, enhances it with some advanced technology, and wraps it in a stylish design inside and out. 




