## Scams Increasing at Alarming Rate

### A warning against companies offering bogus grants

Scammers often try to lure in victims by offering methods to get free money, and during a recession or economic downturn, the number of these types of scams increase dramatically.

A new twist on "free money" scams comes disguised as government grants. CDI Resources and IC Services are "grant" companies that have unsatisfactory records with the Betto two or more complaints.

CDI Resources, also doing business as CDI Solutions, is based in Tukwila, Wash. BBB has fielded 15 complaints against the company since November, 2007.

IC Services, based in Beaverton, Oregon, has 145 complaints since February, 2006 covering a variety of issues.

Government-grant scams appeal to consumers with a tempting offer: free government grants worth thousands of dollars that are offered to the consumer simply because the consumer is a good taxpayer. All the consumer needs to do

ter Business Bureau due to failure to respond to receive the grant is send an application fee in the form of a cashier's check and the grant money will be sent in return.

Cashier's checks are untraceable and nonrefundable, which is why the scammers request them. The scammer will then take the money and not send the victim anything. Often, scammers operate under companies using several different names, move from city to city.

Remember that the government doesn't contact people out of the blue to offer grants and never requires fees of any kind. Government grants require an application process and aren't given to people just for being good taxpayers.


