

The Portland Development Commission (PDC) requests proposals from experienced development teams interested in purchasing and developing an approximately 32,400 square foot site owned by PDC on NE Martin Luther King, Jr. Blvd. between NE Cook St. and NE Ivy St. in the Oregon Convention Center Urban Renewal Area.

(8) That maximizes the leverage of private resources, while utilizing no more than \$2M in tax increment financing (TIF) assistance; and

(9) That meets PDC diversity requirements.
