

Matsiko is made up of 29 orphaned and at-risk children accompanied by five Ugandan leaders and ten International Children's Network volunteers. However, this choir is unique to all traveling kids' choirs from around the world.

These kids sing not for themselves, but for others like them, in need of sponsorship and a hand up into the world that it out of reach for too many of them. Their distinctive sound comes together to create a truly exceptional performance one will never forget.
