The Housing Authority of the City of Tacoma ("Authority") hereby requests the submission of written proposals from prospective lenders ("Respondents") to provide a construction loan and/or a permanent loan to Salishan Six, LLC, a limited liability company. The Borrower was formed to finance and lease (under long-term leases of land and improvements) a new 90-unit multi-family development known as Salishan Six. The initial members of the Borrower are expected to be the Authority, as Managing Member, and the tax credit investor. The Project is located in Tacoma, Washington. It is being sponsored by the Authority pursuant to a HOPE VI grant from the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development. The Project received an award of \$1,421,507 of 9% Low Income Housing Tax Credits under Section 42 of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986.

As described more fully within the Request for Proposals (RFP), the Authority seeks both construction and permanent financing. The Authority requests that Respondents address both its construction and permanent financing needs. Alternatively, if a Respondent is offering only construction or only permanent financing, please indicate clearly which one. The financing terms are expected to be negotiated and documented no later than August 1, 2008, with closing in November 2008 following HUD review and approval.
