

Overthe past several years, TriMet says it has made several adjustments to its vehicles, making its bus fleet one of the most fuel-efficient in the nation. These actions save more than \$600,000 annually.

TriMet has also transferred \$4.1 million from contingency to offset current fuel costs, as well as elimimuter Rail service between nated 18 staff positions and reduced other programs.
