Fireworks Safety Urged

The state fire marshal and others are encouraging people to keep it legal and keep it safe when using fireworks in celebration of the 4th of July.

Oregon law bans possession, use or sale of fireworks that fly, explode or travel more than six feet on the ground or 12 inches into the air.

Steps to safer use of fireworks include keeping water available by using a garden hose or bucket and keeping children and pets away from fireworks.

After lighting fireworks, never relight a dud and after 15 to 20 minutes soak all used fireworks in a bucket of water before disposal.

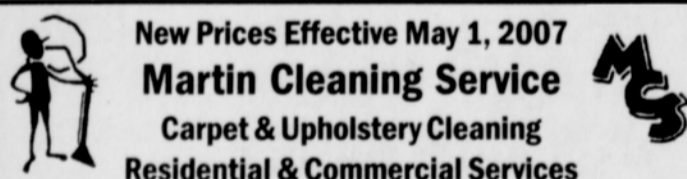
