NAACP Leaders Protest Racist Cartoon

The Portland Branch of the NAACP stood up against a racist cartoon seen as advocating the assassination of President Obama and promoting dehumanizing racial stereotypes in a NAACP Nationwide Day of Action.

"Make Murdoch Fix it," was the rallying cry of NAACP members and other community leaders in cities across the county demanding that NewsCorp Chairman and owner Rubert Murdoch make changes immediately to his New York Post and Fox News outlets.

The New York Post cartoon showed police shooting a chimpanzee with a caption saying," I guess they've have to find someone else to write the next stimulus bill," juxtaposed against a photo of President Obama singing the stimulus package.

The local protest took place Thursday at Reflections Bookstore in northeast Portland, drawing several local leaders and supporters.

Portland NAACP President Bishop H. L. Hodge distributed a letter the group sent to the Patrick McCreery, the general manager of KPTV, Channel 12, asking the local FOX-TV affili- news coverage, and demand photo call from the Portland Iowa.





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
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
