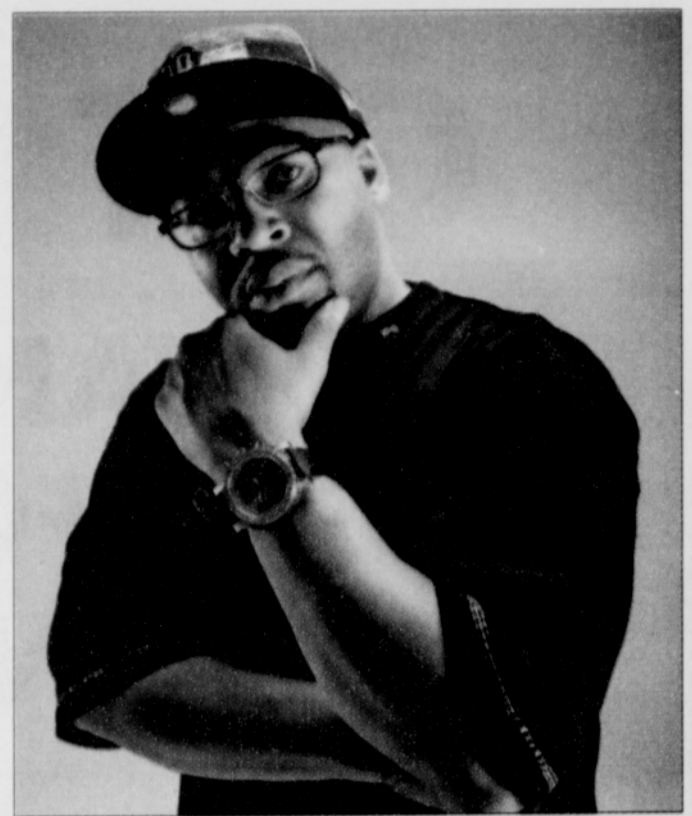
Topics of discussion will include the state of business, unity, progression and growth of the local hip-hop scene; identifying and utilizing Portland resources; and how to improve

Congo-born singer, songwriter and composer Ricardo Lemvo will have hips swinging with his bold, rhythmic dance tunes Wednesday, Aug. 19 as part of the Oregon Zoo's summer concert series, presented by NW Natural.

Using an authentic blend of Afro-Cuban music and pan-African styles, Lemvo and his band, Makina Loca, take listen-

ers around the world with lyrics in Spanish, Lingala, Kikongo, Portuguese, English, French, and Turkish.

"Lemvo's music is truly infectious in any language," said Krista Swan, zoo events coordinator. "You can't help but stand up and dance!"

Lemvo was born and raised in the Congo, but moved to Los Angeles at age 15 to pur-

sue his studies and his passion for music. In 1990, he formed Makina Loca and began producing songs that celebrate life and inspire listeners to cast aside their worries and dance.
