Swift to Host 'Saturday Night'

Question: Who plays Kanye West

(AP) -- Taylor Swift will have the stage to herself next month --- with no interruptions - when she hosts "Saturday Night Live."

The only question is: Who will play Kanye West?

Last month, West hijacked Swift's acceptance speech after she became the first country star to win best female video at the MTV Video Music Awards. West grabbed the microphone and declared that Beyonce's nominated video for "Single Ladies" was one of the "best videos of all time."

Swift called the chance to host on Nov. 7 "mind-blowing" and says it's been difficult to keep it a secret since producers asked her during the summer. She said she loved her experience in January when she was a musical guest, and will again perform when she hosts

Swift has been nominated for four Country Music Awards, including Entertainer of the Year, the youngest artist in history to be honored. She has had five No. 1 singles on country charts and two consecutive No. 1 songs on the pop charts.






Predators of the Serengeti -- Come hear the roar as the Oregon Zoo shows off its newest and most ambitious ex-
