Demos in **Football Semifinals**

Jefferson High School has advanced to the semifinals of the Oregon 5A football championship series for the second year in a row.

The Democrats face Sherwood on Saturday, Dec. 5 at 3 p.m. at PGE Park.

Jefferson beat Glencoe, 41-21 last Saturday in Hillsboro to set up the matchup.

The 5A Portland Interscholastic League champions were able to stop Glencoe from scoring on a long opening drive and then scored four times in a row. The Democrats won rave reviews for their big offensive line, defensive pursuit and speed to turn the game into a physical mismatch.

The upcoming matchup with Sherwood will be the second this year between the two teams. Sherwood beat Jefferson 40-7 on Sept.

If Jefferson should reach the final it would be the first time since 1959 -- an era that included players such as Mel Renfro and Terry Baker.

(AP) -- Tiger Woods did not pear to be driving under the influence and showed no signs of having been in a fight in the minutes after his car crash outside his mansion, an attorney for the neighbors who dialed 911 said Tuesday.

Woods' injuries were "consistent with a car wreck and inconsistent with him being beat up," attorney Bill Sharpe said. "The scratches on his face were consistent with someone who maybe was in a minor car accident and hit his head on the windshield. ... None of his injuries looked like he was beat up

by his wife."

Civil War has Rose Bowl on Line

Oregon hosts historic matchup

(AP) -- It is being dubbed the War of the Roses

The 113th Civil War rivalry game between 10thranked Oregon and 16thranked Oregon State this Thursday night will decide the Pac-10's representative in the Rose Bowl. And the state of Oregon has never seen anything quite like it.

Tickets for the game reached \$500 apiece on Craigslist.org this week. One pair, offered for \$1,000, included an unpaid reservation for the night at a nearby hotel, an additional \$159 cost.

The frenzy over tickets prompted Oregon Attorney General John

Kroger to issue a warning over counterfeit tickets.

"Con artists and scammers routinely try to capitalize off of highly antici-

pated events to pad their own wallets," Kroger's office said in an advisory that offered tips for spotting scams.

Autzen Stadium seats more than 54,000. Oregon officials also sell some 5,000 standingroom only tickets. All were long ago sold out.

Oregon (9-2, 7-1) hasn't been to the Rose Bowl since the 1994 season, and Oregon State

(8-3, 6-2) hasn't been there since the 1964 season.

It is the first time in the history of the rivalry game that both teams are playing for a trip to Pasadena.

The woman, Rachel Uchitel, denied having an affair with Woods when contacted by The Associated Press.

Sharpe said the Adams family did not see the crash and did not see Woods' wife with a golf club.

"One thing we want to make clear is that Mrs. Woods' attitude was consistent with her being concerned about her injured husband," Sharpe said. "Mrs. Woods was trying to help him. Mrs. Woods was worried about her husband. She was concerned."

Woods withdrew Monday from his own golf tournament, citing injuries from the crash.
