

Jay-Z tops in music category

(AP) -- The heart-wrenching story of an illiterate and abused Harlem teen who finds hope in a classroom of misfits led the nominations for the 41st annual NAACP Image Awards.

"Precious: Based on the Novel 'Push' by Sapphire" added to its awards-season momentum last week with a leading eight nominations, earning nods for director Lee Daniels, star Gabourey Sidibe and supporting actors Mariah Carey, Mo'Nique, Paula Patton and Lenny Kravitz. "Precious" was also nominated for outstanding motion pic-

ture and outstanding independent film.

Other movies nominated include "Invictus," "Michael Jackson's This Is It," "The Blind Side" and "The collaborations with Alicia Keys, Princess and the Frog." "Blind Side" stars Sandra Bullock and Quinton recognized. Rihanna and Keys were Aaron, "Princess" star Anika Noni Rose, and "Invictus" star Morgan male artist, along with India.
