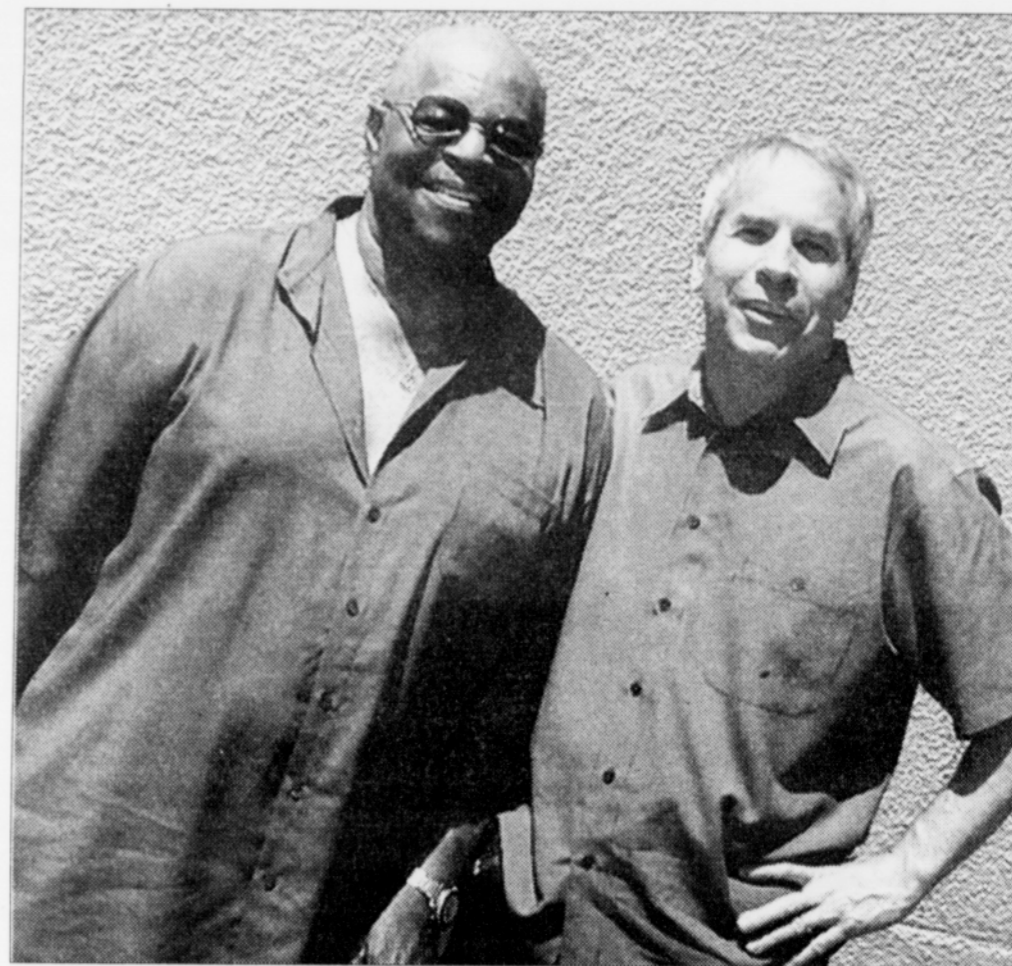

## Musical Tribute to 'Jumptown'

The community is invited to enjoy a free musical tribute to "Jumptown," the name attributed in a book to the former black community that existed in the Rose Quarter area of north and northeast Portland before construction of Memorial Coliseum back in the early 1960s.

The Portland Trail Blazers will sponsor the performance by King Louie, Sweet Baby James, and the All-Star Band on Friday, Feb. 5 from 6 p.m. to 9 p.m. at the Northeast Multicultural Senior Center, 5325 N.E. Martin Luther King Jr. Blvd. at Killingsworth Street. The Blazers are proposing to renovate the coliseum and adjacent properties in the Rose Quarter area with sports and entertainment venues.

The public is invited to share neighborhood memories from the past at the Friday concert. Refreshments will be provided.
