A style called 'Bubbleism'

Onda Gallery, 2215 N.E. Alberta St., currently hosts works by Marcio Diaz, a Nicaraguan contemporary artist living in Seattle. The exhibit runs through Feb. 23.



Diaz uses paints in unique version of pointilism which he calls bubbleism. Each small pool of color is formed by concentric circles in carefully selected tones which eventually help form the larger image of the painting.
