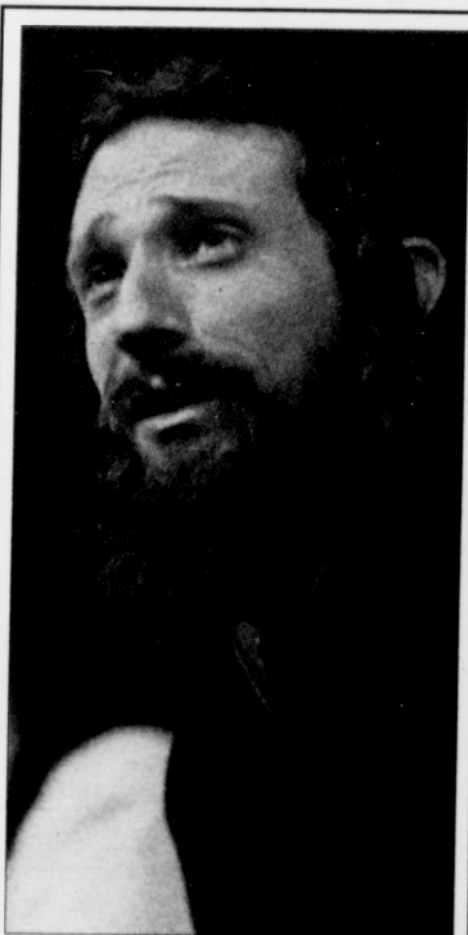
Artists will perform songs from celebrated films including "Labyrinth," "Halloween," "The Royal Tenenbaums,"

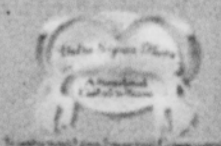
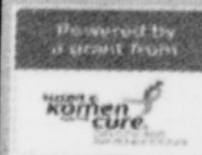
