Council to scrape up some cash.

But the board voted last year to stop operations after lackluster fundraising, a growing debt, and from a change in the contract with the city that Flagg said would require the IFCC to pay its \$80,000 utility bill.

As the IFCC prepares to close, Flagg is left with her

memories of a place that helped set her trajectory as an artist. One of her fondest was the hip-hop show "Good Foot", produced by an artist named Kumari.

Flagg, impressed by the project, encouraged Kumari to go all out and sell tickets for it. After attracting a standing-room-only crowd for a performance Flagg described as absolutely gorgeous, Kumari was left with a wad of cash that would serve as seed money.

"I think you're lucky to have a job were I can say at least once, wow, at least that happened. I had that happen more times than I can count," Flagg said.
