ecoroof incentive program is part of Portland's Grey to Green effort to increase Portland's green stormwater management infrastructure, protect sensitive natural areas and improve habitat.

The incentive pays up to \$5 per square foot for new ecoroof projects in the city. Ecoroofs in Portland typically cost between \$5 and \$20 per square foot. Industrial, residential, commercial and mixed-use projects are eligible for the incentive.

The city has begun a new cycle of ecoroof incentives and is accepting applications through June 1. Environmental Services will award incentives this summer. The city will continue to make funds available until 2013,
