Summer series begins Friday

The Oregon Zoo summer concert series kicks off Friday, June 25, as three-time Grammy nominee Jewel takes the stage to perform hits from throughout her multiplatinum career. The concert series, sponsored by NW Natural, features more than 15 shows from June through September.

After releasing one of the most successful debut albums of all time—1995's "Pieces of You"—Jewel has gone on to sell more than 27 million albums worldwide. Her latest release, "Sweet and Wild," came out earlier this month.

Opening the show is heart-on-his-sleeve country crooner Radney Foster.

Nigerian Afrobeat superstar Femi Kuti and his band, The Positive Force, will appear Friday, July 2 in the second concert of the summer season.

The concert series runs through Sept. 1, when Cyndi Lauper, the quintessential girl who wants to have fun, takes the stage.
