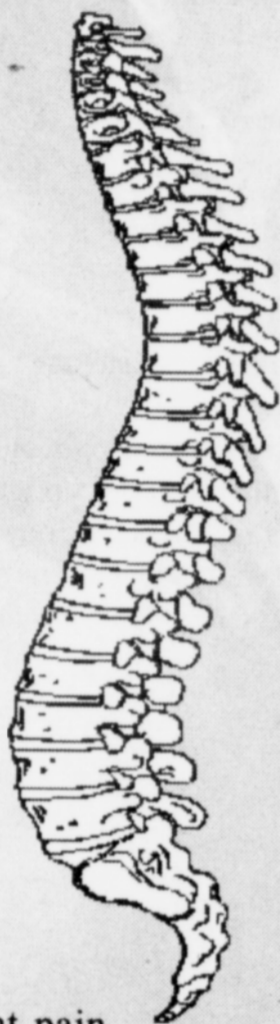

According to this Holy Servant, a man of God, pay attention to this impartation. "Let the Spirit of God reign" in our choice for a President.

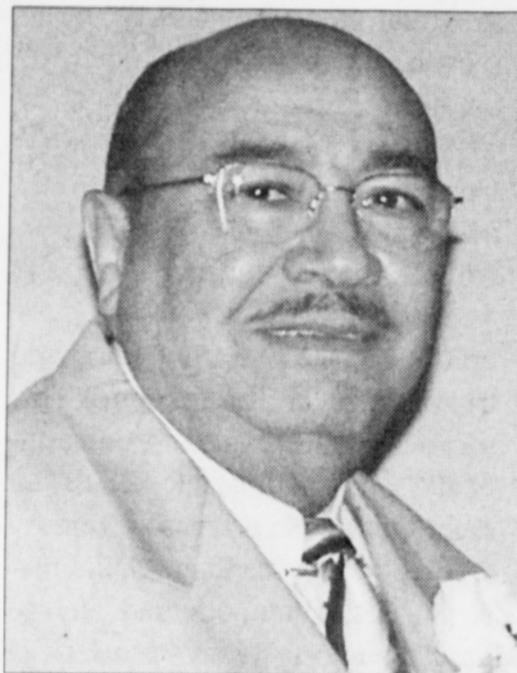
