2010 Subaru Outback 2.51 Premium / ADD

The Subaru Premium-trimmed 2.5i adds a 10-way power adjustable driver's seat, 17-inch alloy wheels, a leather steering wheel, auto up/ down driver's window and fog lights, and raises the sticker price to \$24,595. Optional fare includes the Lineartronic CVT, all-weather package, a 440-watt Harman Kardon stereo and a sunroof. The Outback's standard all-wheel drive, rugged

The 2.5i trims are powered by a 2.5-liter boxer four rated at 170 horsepower at 5600 rpm and 170 lb-ft of torque at 4000 rpm. The 2.5i is outfitted with an all-new 6-speed manual transmission from the factory. The tested vehicle came equipped with the Subaru's Lineartronic CVT, which selects any ratio between its highest and lowest available ratios at any time and adds \$1000. This means a more efficient use of power and better fuel economy. In the past, manual gearboxes got better mileage than their automatic counterparts, but in the Outback the 6nature and general outdoorsy vibe speed delivers 19 mpg city/27 mpg headlights, adjustable roof rails and

lifestyles and everyday commuting. mpg/29 mpg

> The design of the unibody shell and the low, horizontally-opposed engine keep the center of gravity low, minimizing side-to-side weight transfer when cornering. Springs and shocks are matched and tuned moderately firmly for good control with minimal body roll when cornering, despite the considerable 8.7 inches of ground clearance, which allows easy and safe dirt-road driving and protection from road debris that might surprisingly appear.

The base 2.5i comes standard with 16-inch steel wheels, automatic

fit right in with typical active highway, while the CVT posts 22 cross bars, full power accessories, cruise control, a tilt-and-telescoping steering column, height-adjustable driver seat and a four-speaker stereo with CD player and an auxiliary audio jack. The 2.5i Premium adds 17-inch alloy wheels, fog lights, rear privacy glass, eight-way power driver seat (with power lumbar) and a leather-wrapped steering wheel. Optional on the Premium is an All-Weather package that adds heated side mirrors, a windshield wiper deicer and heated front seats. The optional Harman Kardon stereo includes nine speakers, a six-CD changer and Bluetooth phone and audio connectivity

The Outback will catch you off guard every time you step out of the driver seat, because of its high ground clearance, while driving it, you feel a relatively low center of gravity which adds to the feeling of a low ground vehicle. The Outback's improved interior space and comfort, also help to improve both ride and handling qualities. It may have a station wagon look however the smooth, comfortable and great handling describes the Outback's onroad behavior. The outback is truly a versatile performs while in town and off road while providing spacious cargo room. I feel like I was driving a SUV.
