Antique Cars and Airplanes

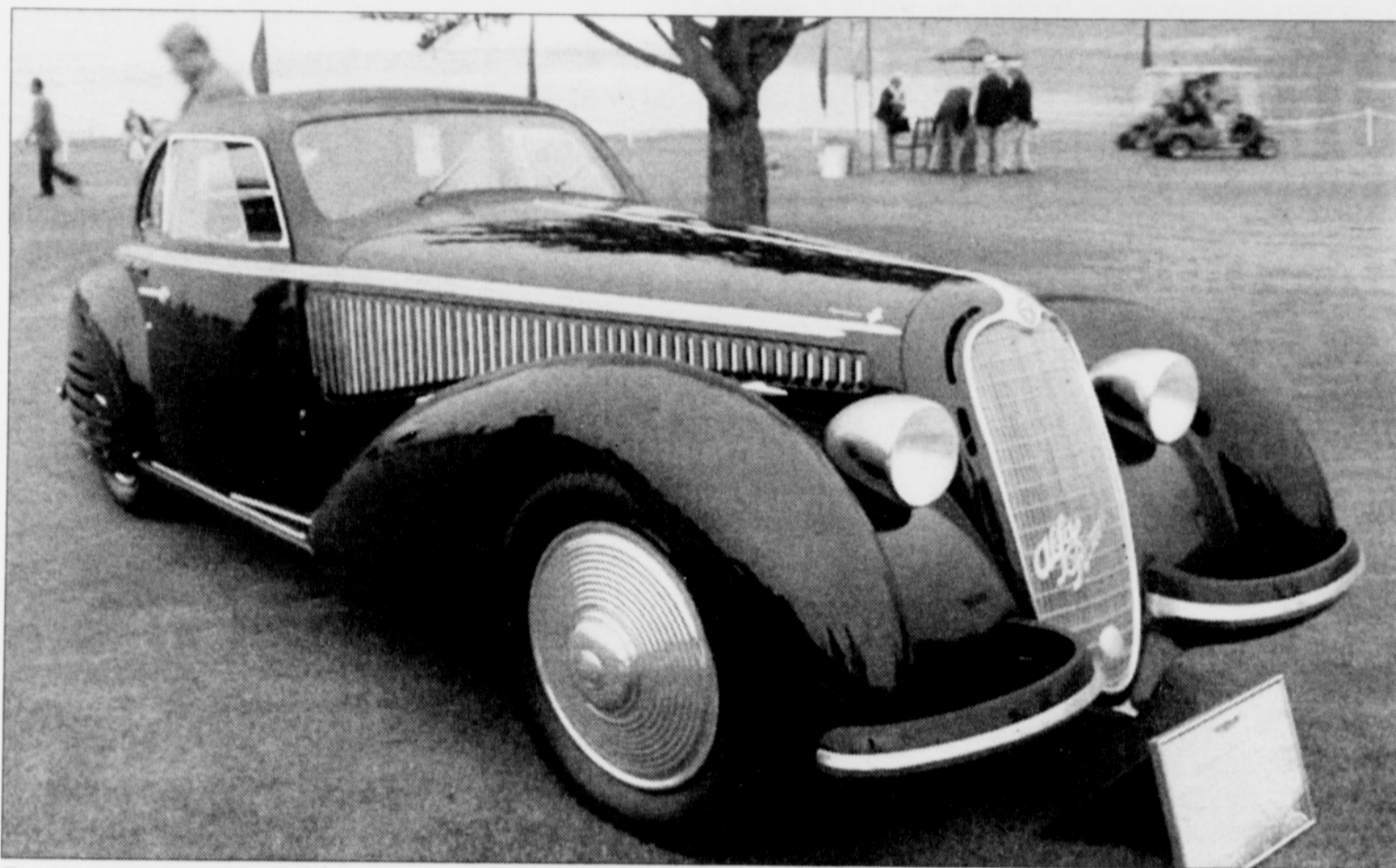
Vancouver hosts weekend shows

Two weekend events in Vancouver will feature rare collections of antique cars and airplanes, including for the first time the prestigious Concours d'Elegance.

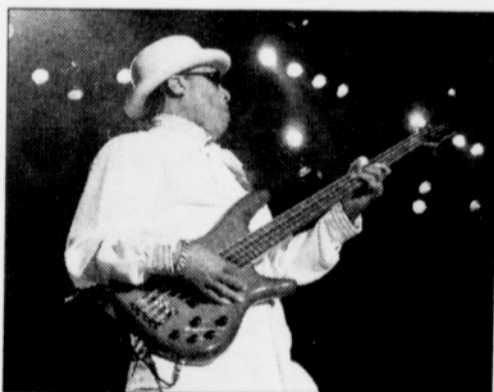
Unique antique and vintage airplanes from across the country will be on display Friday, Aug. 20 through Sunday, Aug. 22 at the historic Pearson Airfield. Participants can see more than 200 planes and meet the pilots, then visit the adjacent Pearson Air Museum for a glimpse into "The Golden Age of Aviation." Admission to the Northwest Antique Aircraft Association's fly-in is \$8 for adults and \$5 for children 6-12 (under 6 are free). Gap Band Bassist Remembered

Robert Wilson, the bassist for the funk and R&B group the Gap Band, has died. He was 53.

His death on Sunday in Los Angeles was confirmed by Karen Lee, publicist for his brother and Gap Band singer Charlie Wilson.

Robert Wilson had been touring over the past few weeks, including a stop in his hometown in Tulsa, Okla.

Wilson provided the bass backbone for the trio, which also included another brother, Ronnie. They rocketed to stardom in the 1980s with hits like "Outstanding," "You Dropped a Bomb On Me" and "Yearning for Your Love."
