to work in the vocation program when she heard a Kenyan woman describe how she had repeatedly been beaten by her husband. But once the woman had an ability to earn money, the beatings stopped, Hoxworth said.

"That was powerful," she said of the woman's testimony. "Domestic violence was the norm. The training (in the sewing program) changes the dynamics of their families."

The Molly Hightower Endowed Scholarship was established by the Class of 2010 in memory of Hightower, who died in the January earthquake in Haiti while volunteering with special-needs orphans.

No stranger to activism and volunteerism, from her first day at the north Portland school, Hoxworth was motivated by the university's mission of teaching, faith and service. In her three years on campus, she has served locally, nationally and globally through the Moreau Center for Service and Leadership.

Assisting people with disabilities in Portland, helping rebuild a flood-ravaged rural Oregon town, leading groups of UP students on trips with Habitat for Humanity, twice travelling to Kenya, exploring agricultural community issues - Hoxworth's experience is as deep as it is varied.

"She is truly a servant scholar and global citizen motivated by a sincere compassion and concern for others," said Laura Goble, director of the Moreau Center. "She has a vibrant energy that lights up the world and has - and will continue to - perpetuate Molly's legacy."
