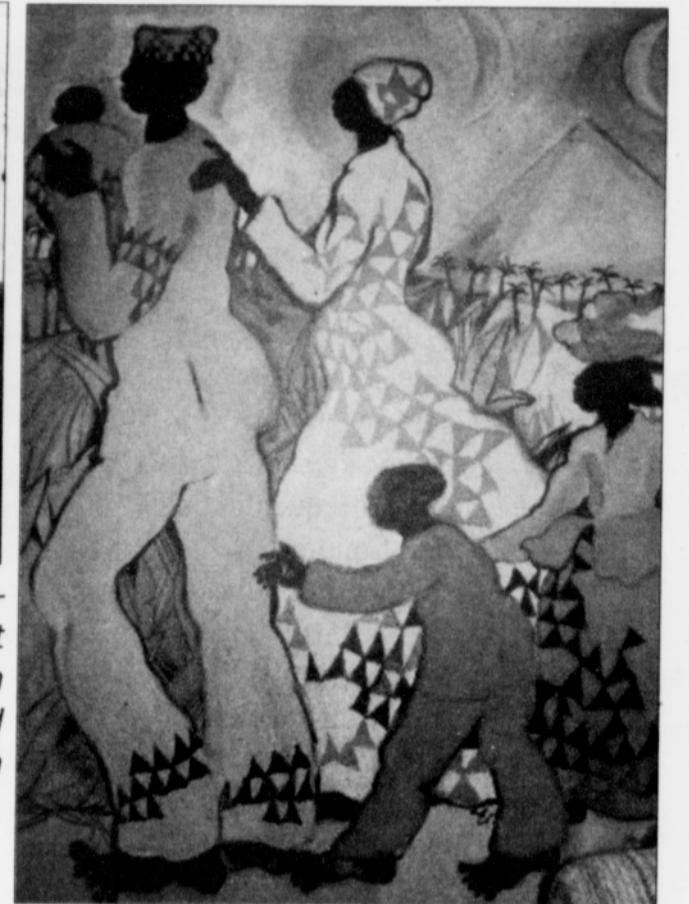

Revisiting Charlotte Lewis

Exhibit opens at North Portland Library branch

Graphic designs by the late Charlotte Lewis, a community artist and muralist whose artistry graced the exteriors and interiors of many public buildings in Portland, will be on display during October at the North Portland branch of the Multnomah

County Library at Northeast Killingsworth Street and Commercial Avenue.

Lewis' murals include Children of Humanity in the North Precinct Community Policing Station at Northeast Martin Luther King Boulevard and Killingsworth Street; several works in McMenamins Kennedy School; and graphic designs in the lobby of the American Red Cross- Oregon Trail Chapter building on North Williams Avenue.

Charlotte's work will also be included in the "Walls of Heritage, Walls of Pride: African American Murals" national touring exhibit opening at the Oregon Historical Society in November.

The North Portland Library's exhibit can be seen during the following hours: Sundays, 1:30-3:30 p.m.; Tuesdays, noon - 4:30 p.m.; Wednesdays, noon - 7:30 p.m.; Fridays, noon - 5:30 p.m.; Saturdays, 1:30 - 5:30 p.m.

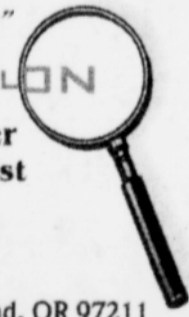
