

Mid-Life Crisis Brings Laughs on Stage

Present Laughter, an audacious comedy dealing with a man's complicated mid-life crisis, opens this week in the Mago Hunt Theater on the University of Portland campus, 5000 N. Willamette Blvd.

Perhaps Noel Coward's most autobiographical play, Present Laughter has been revived frequently both in New York and London.

Garry Essendine, a popular and pampered actor, is busily making preparations for an extended overseas tour to Africa with devoted secretary, Monica. However, Garry, battling a midlife crisis, finds his plans are complicated first by Daphne, a beautiful stage- struck ingénue, then by a fatuously ardent aspiring playwright, Roland Maule. 
