Writer of Human Struggles Honored

(AP) -- Peruvian writer and one-time presidential candidate Mario Vargas Llosa, a chronicler of human struggles against authoritarianism in Latin America, won the 2010 Nobel prize for literature on Thursday.

political opinions," the 74-year-old author said at a news conference in New York.

"I think Latin American literature deals with power and politics and this was inevitable.

A leading member of a generation of writers behind the resurgence in Latin American literature in the 1960s, Vargas Llosa was a champion of the left in his youth and later evolved into an outspoken conservative, a shift that infuriated much of Latin America's leftist intelligentsia.

We in Latin America have not solved basic problems such as freedom," Vargas Llosa said.

The Swedish Academy awarding the \$1.5 million prize said Vargas Llosa had been chosen "for his cartography of structures of power and his trenchant images of the individual's resistance, revolt and defeat."
