and Latin music in addition to their own original compositions.

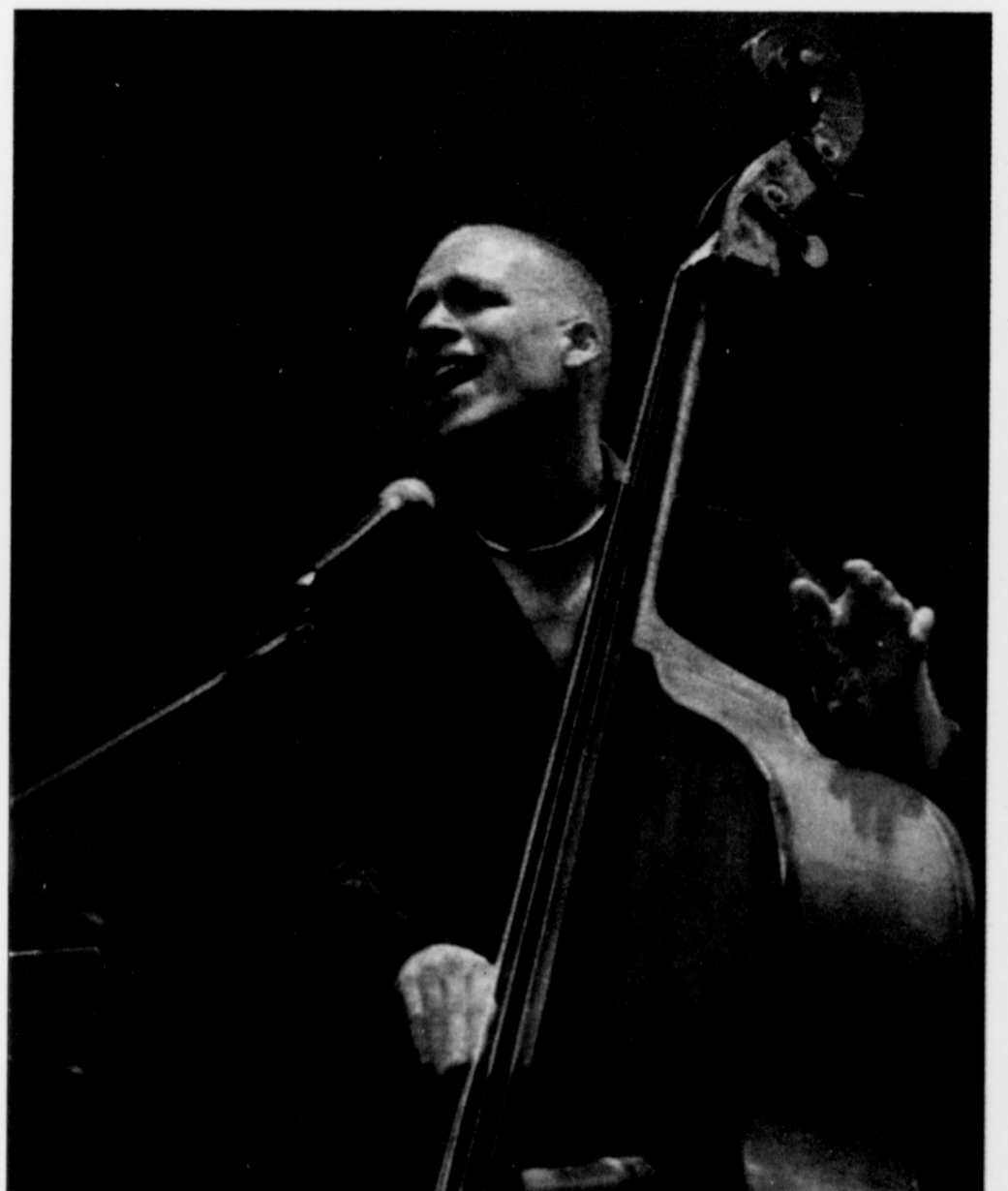

Essence of Expression

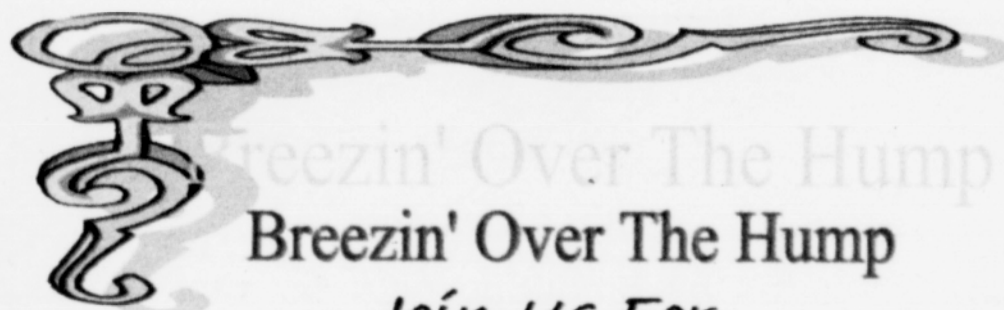
