Group Helps Homeless Youth

Goal is finding a sustainable food source

Each day in downtown Portland, 40 to 60 homeless youngsters walk through the doors of P:ear, a non-profit hub for homeless youth outreach, where they can count on volunteers to provide them with nutritious meals and free opportunities for education, art, and recreation.

This fall, Portland State stu-

dents are teaming up with the organization to make sure P:ear's pantries and refrigerators are stocked with a steady supply of food groups, so that transitional youth can continue to have nourishing foods on the table all year long.

Students are inviting the surrounding Portland community, including local farmers and farmer's markets, to help provide nutritional and locally-produced foods for those living without stable meals and a roof over their head.

As of now, P:ear lacks regular donations of whole grains, beef, poultry, and dairy prod-

ucts. If those interested in supporting the mission of P:ear and our homeless youth community, are able to donate any of these items, it would be helpful and appreciated by the students, staff, and cooks in the kitchen.

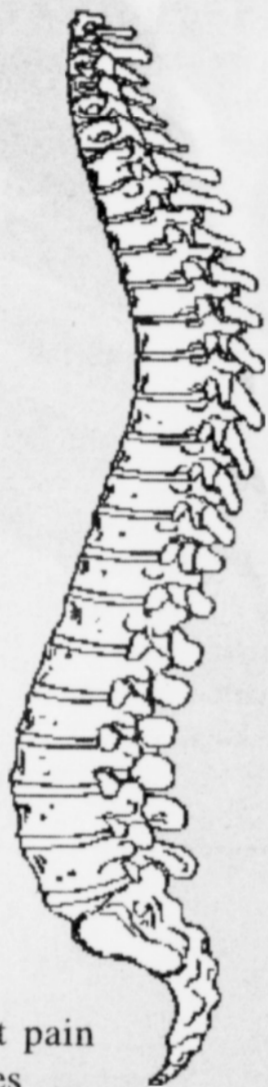
