## All-Out Tap Sensation

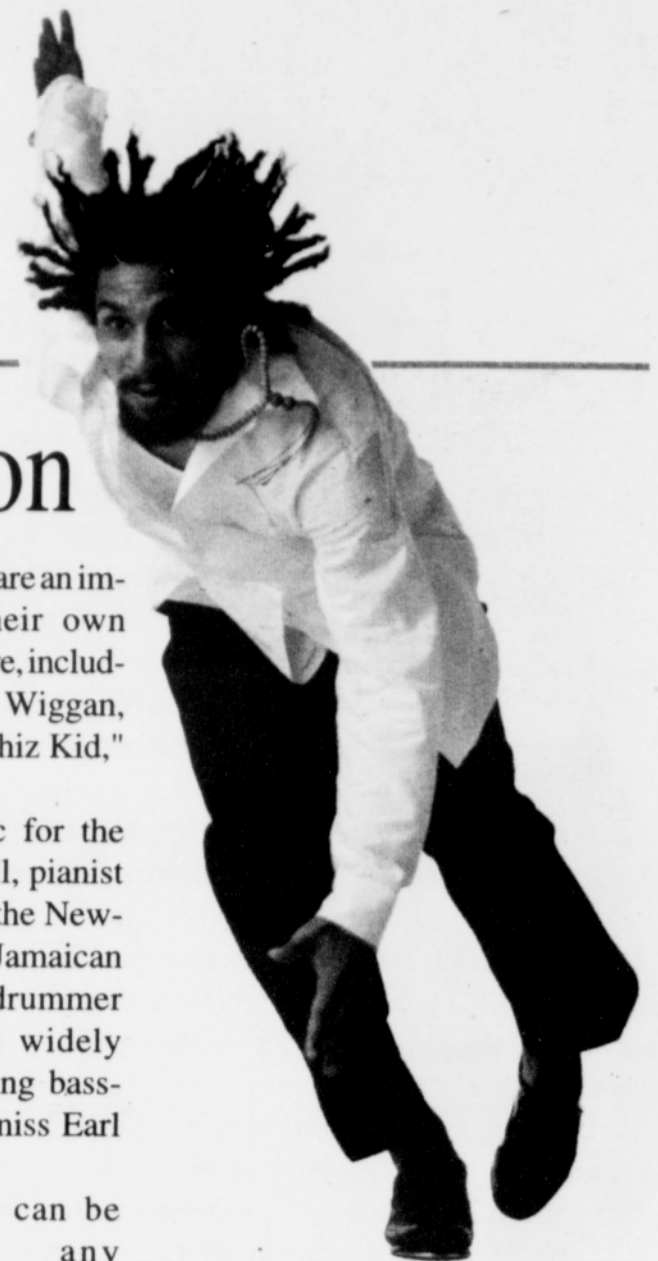

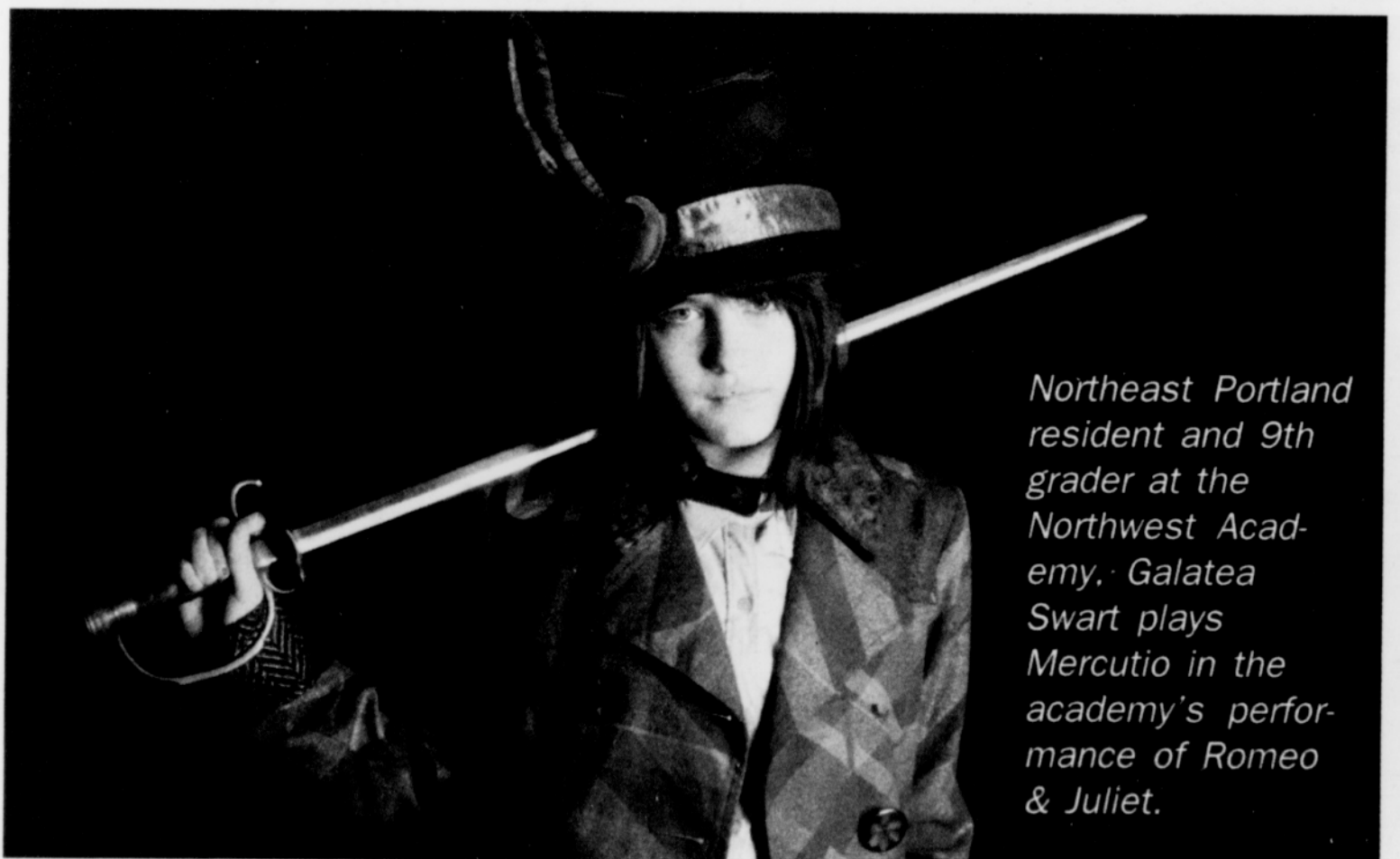
## Night of Joy, Cheer
