The vigil will be followed by a free 8 p.m. screening and question and answer session of Dan Rather's "Pornland," a documentary about the sex trafficking business in Portland with attendance by some of the people that were part of the film including Rather's producers.

The conference itself will offer breakout sessions, networking receptions, keynote speakers, a luncheon, exhibit resource expo, and continuing education trainings.

A brunch with actress and advocate Daryl Hannah will be

one of the highlights. The Jane Velez-Mitchell Journalism Award will also be presented. The emcee for the conference is Alexis Del Cid, of KOIN 6.
