New Home Sales Extremely Low

(AP) -- Sales of new homes in the United States have slumped to the almost nine months for the all the lowest level since the 1960's, official data shows, offering more evidence -- if no more homes are built. of an lingering real estate crisis.

in February, the Commerce Department reported last week, to a seasonally adjusted total of 250,000 sales during the month.

That marked the lowest number of units sold since 1963, when records began.

At the current rate it would take new homes on the market to be sold

The National Association of Sales tumbled nearly 17 percent Realtors said sales of alreadyowned homes fell 9.6 percent in February.

> Despite low home prices and ultra-low interest rates the market has faltered as banks have tightened up loan requirements, ending years of profligate consumer borrowing.


