Though a deeper understanding of the human spirit is one ultimate goal Gion takes from his art work, he also revels in sculpting animals, mostly dogs.

Using a similar process as with humans, Gion would rather have the live animal with him to capture the dog's personality and take measurements. Often, he will go to dog shows to commission portraits for owners' prized pets. Over the course of a three- or four-day show, Gion acquires the shape of the dogs' head and takes a series of photos that he uses to complete the sculpture back in his studio, and up to sixteen weeks later, he delivers the piece.
