The University of Oregon is soliciting qualifications from architectural firms interested in providing design through construction administration services for Straub Hall Deferred Maintenance and Seismic Upgrade project on the University of Oregon campus in Eugene, Oregon.

Briefly, Straub Hall was constructed in 1928-29 as a dormitory and served as such until 1971 when the building was converted into an academic building principally to house the Psychology Department. The basic scope of the project is to retrofit or replace existing heating, ventilation, electrical, plumbing, and lighting systems with more energy and water efficient systems; enhance the thermal performance of the building envelope; implement seismic upgrades; and improve accessibility.

Architectural firms responding to the Request for Qualifications (RFQ) must have an office location in Oregon and be licensed or have an application in process to practice architecture in Oregon.
