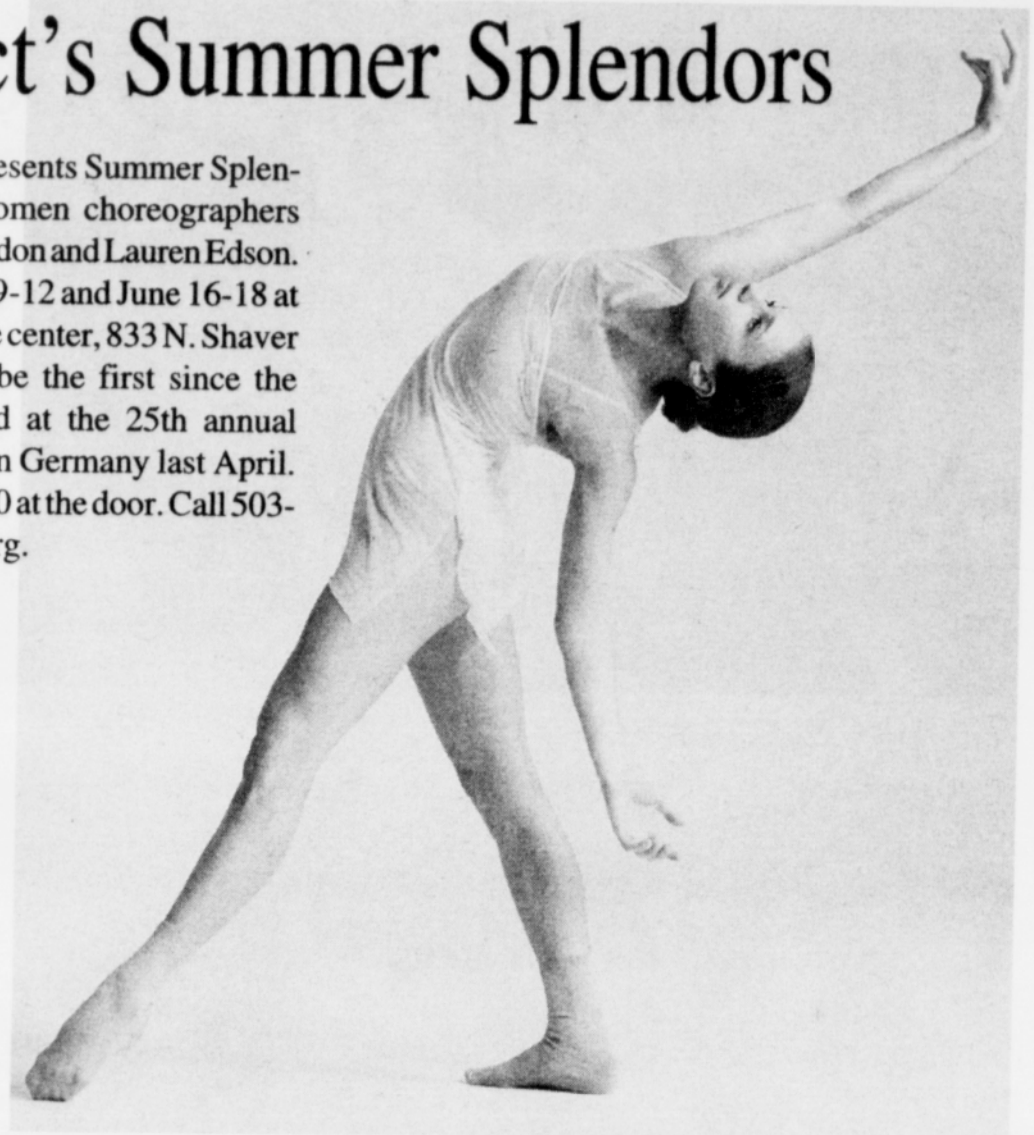

Art Exhibits for Airport Travelers

Portland International Airport has unveiled two art exhibits to delight travelers and celebrate Northwest creativity.

In "Art from Nature," artists Lenny Wilson, Maria T. Jacobs, Anne Scott and Emilie Lapham use innovation and meticulous skill to create everyday objects from natural plant materials. Under an artist's hand, glamorous high heels take shape from a pile of acorns and leaves. Seeds and petals become a tiara. The exhibit is located on Concourse A through Sept. 15.

Artists Tiffany Ludwig and Renee Piechocki created "Trappings: Portraits" after interviewing more than 600 women in 15 states, asking them to respond to the question, "What do you wear that makes you feel powerful?" The exhibit, located at the entrance to Concourse E through Sept. 30, allows participants and viewers to investigate their own relationship to power and assumptions based on appearance and image.

"Our art program is designed to provide a portal into the dynamic cultural life of our region," said Greta Blalock, Port of Portland's PDX art and entertainment coordinator. "Through ongoing relationships
