It's going to be an incredible night of music when indie folk and pop musicians Cheyenne Marie Mize and Vandaveer perform Thursday, June 23, at Mississippi Studios, 3939 N. Mississippi Ave.

The indefatigable Vandaveer, birth name Mark Charles Heidiger with the angelic Rose Geurin, is a hardened road warrior, clocking in over 500 shows since 2007.

Mize supported Vandaveer on a recent Euro-

pean run and things went well enough to necessitate an encore here in the states.

Mize is hot off her 2010 release *Before Lately* and the buzz generated from NPR's *All Songs Considered* crew proclaiming her one of the best discoveries at SXSW 2011.

Vandaveer just dropped a remarkable new album, *Dig Down Deep*, as well as an equally badass accompanying video.

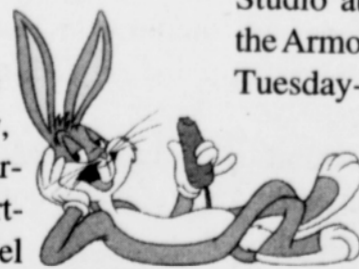
### Chronicles of Narnia Exhibition --
