

Space Stories and Star-Gazing Party

Astronomy Day at OMSI with Astronaut Mike Barratt

Gorge State Parks, Sunriver Observatory, Portland State University Meteorite Lab, and Vancouver Sidewalk Astronomers, will answer questions, lead hands-on activities and discuss space science.

On Saturday, July 23, in celebration of Astronomy Day, the incredible wonders of the universe become known as OMSI presents a full day into night festival of all things celestial, free with paid museum admission.

For an in-depth, first person account of life in space, local astronaut Michael Barratt, M.D. will present free public lectures in the Kendall Planetarium at 11:30 a.m. and 2:30 p.m., followed by audience questions.

Starry-eyed guests will have the opportunity to learn little-known facts about the universe, constellations, stars and planets.

With NASA since 1991, Barratt spent 199 days in space as a member of Expeditions 19 and 20 in 2009 and most recently served on the final mission for Space Shuttle Discovery.

Space travel and the fascinating realities of life on the International Space Station are expected hot topics as Camas-born, former "OMSI kid" astronaut Mike Barratt is the featured guest and speaker.

Topping off the activities is a weather-permitting Star Party on site at OMSI's east parking lot. The party begins at 9:30 p.m. with an introductory talk by OMSI Planetarium Director Jim Todd, followed by star viewings and a close-up look at Saturn and more through binoculars and telescopes.

On OMSI's front plaza at 10 a.m. until 4 p.m., local astronomy experts from local clubs and organizations including Pine Mountain Observatory, Rose City Astronomers, Columbia River

The day's events are free, but space is limited and reservations are recommended by visiting omsi.edu.
