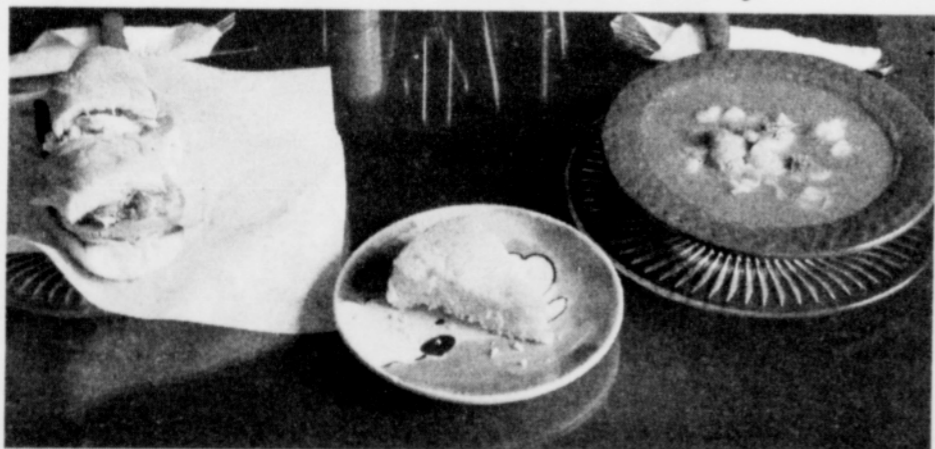

The Portland based classic quartet with pianist Ramsey Embick, bassist Eric Gruber and drummer Alan Jones will play Trane's signature Love Supreme suite as well as the time-honored Coltrane favorites Chasin the Trane, Naima, Giant Steps, The Night has a Thousand Eyes, My Favorite Things and Impressions.

The PDX Jazz at the Mission Theater series will resume this fall with two internationally acclaimed trumpet stars - Sept. 29, ECM recording artist Tomasz Stanko and Oct. 27 the Vietnam native and Pat Metheny band-mate Cuong Vu.
