The Portland City Auditor's Independent Police Review (IPR) division is responsible for the civilian oversight of the Portland Police Bureau (Police Bureau). IPR is monitored and advised by a nine-member Citizen Review Committee (CRC).

CRC holds appeal hearings of police misconduct investigations; listens to community concerns; engages in trainings to increase cultural awareness; reviews Police Bureau policies; and advises IPR on complaint handling processes.

CRC members are appointed by Portland City Council to serve three-year terms.

Candidates must be Portland, Oregon, residents or business owners, and be impartial and objective without conflicts of interest regarding law enforcement.

The volunteers are a diverse crew of dedicated individuals. Most have day jobs, but enjoy the few hours a week they get to share their knowledge about tools

while meeting new faces in the neighborhood.
