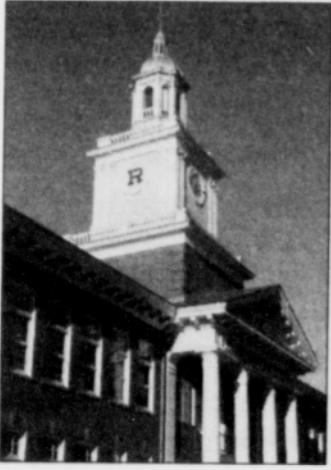

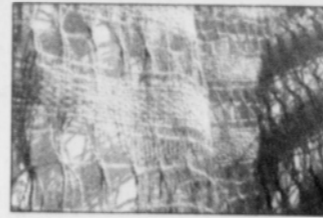
Homecoming -- Join Roosevelt High School in celebration of their Homecoming on Friday, Sept. 23.
