### Top designers to debut their collections

Portland Fashion Week is here with a stellar lineup of runway shows with some of the most exciting designers in the country.

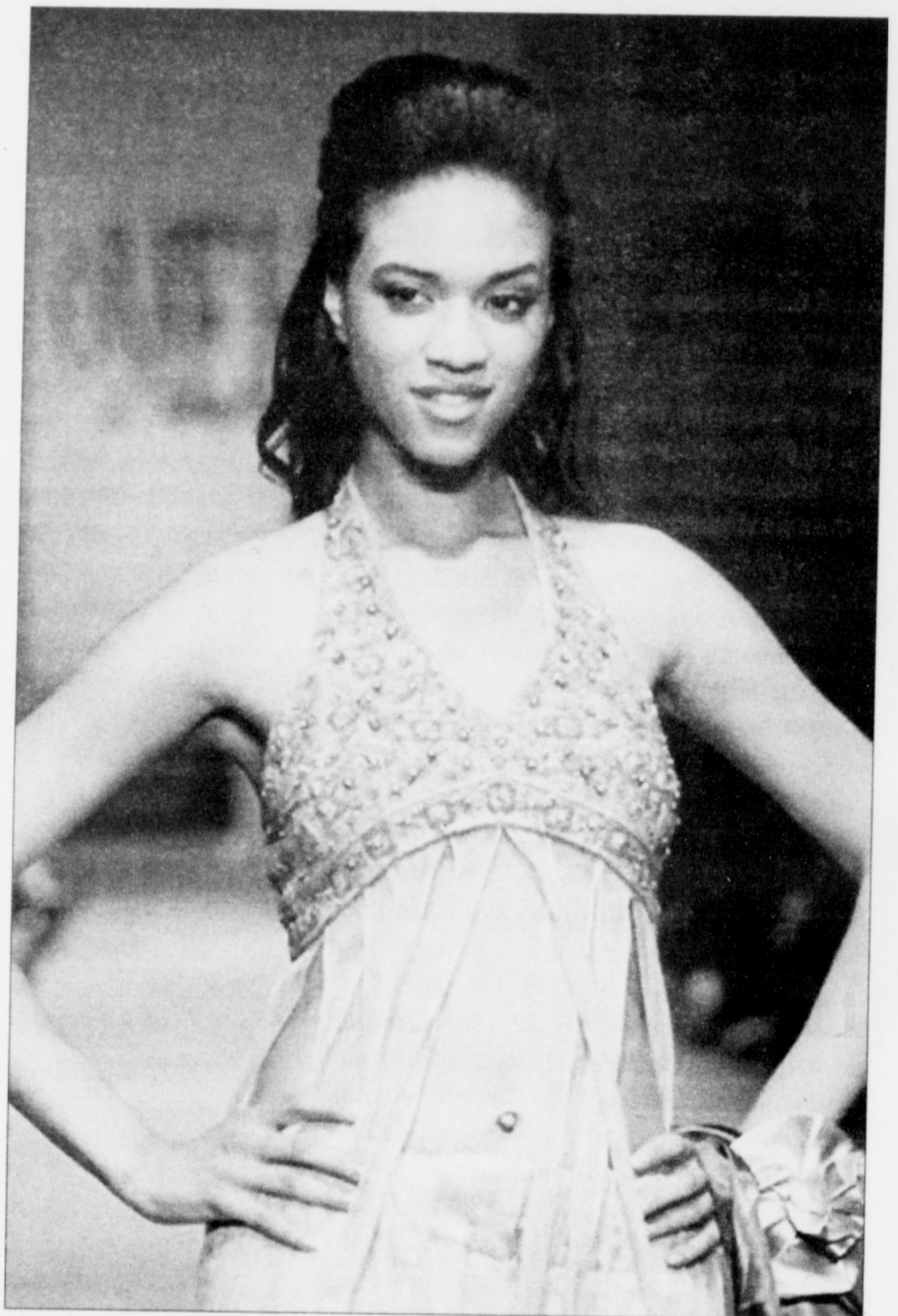
From Project Runway all-stars and winners to world-known eco-sustainable designers, an extraordinary array of designers will debut their collections at the Vigor Industrial Shipyard in Swan Island from Wednesday, Oct. 5 through Saturday, Oct. 8.

Michael Costello from the All-star show, Seth Aaron (winner of Season 7), alum Jay Sario, as well as a designer from the currently airing season, will be showing never-before-seen collections.

Anna Cohen, whose eco-sustainable high-fashion collections have been adorning the pages of global fashion media, will launch two lines designed by her. Ethos Paris and Lenanita are two other widely known eco-fashion collections returning to Portland Fashion Week.

## 'The Color Purple' released as e-book

(AP) — Alice Walker's "The Color Purple," a Pulitzer Prize winner in 1983 and still a widely taught and talked about novel, is finally coming out as an e-book.

Open Road Integrated Media, the digital company co-founded two years ago by former HarperCollins CEO Jane Friedman, has reached an agreement with Walker to release the electronic version of "The Color Purple" and most of her other work.

and the novels "The Temple of My Familiar" and "Possessing the Secret of Joy" were released this month. On Nov. 22, eight more books will be published. The e-books will include author interviews, photographs and personal documents.

Walker is best known for "The Color Purple," set in rural Georgia in the 1930s. It was adapted into a 1985 Steven Spielberg film of the same name and more recently into a Broadway musical.

## Library Links to Kindle Books

Multnomah County Library cardholders can now borrow downloadable books on their Kindles, or any mobile device running the free Kindle app, such as iPhone, iPad, Android and more. More than 10,000 titles are available.

To download a book for Kindle from Multnomah County Library,

a patron needs both a library card and an Amazon account. Here's how it works: The patron selects a downloadable title in the library catalog or directly via Library2Go, clicks "Get for Kindle" if the title is available, and follows the prompts. If the title is checked out, patrons can select "place a hold."

"This long-anticipated service from Amazon is a welcome addition to public libraries across the country, and certainly for the

patrons of Multnomah County Library," said Vailey Oehlke, director of libraries. "Library lovers who have adopted reading devices have long been asking for this service. Now, library patrons have yet another way to take the library and its books with them wherever they go."

Library staff have compiled a guide to help patrons through this new process, and will update it as new information becomes available.
