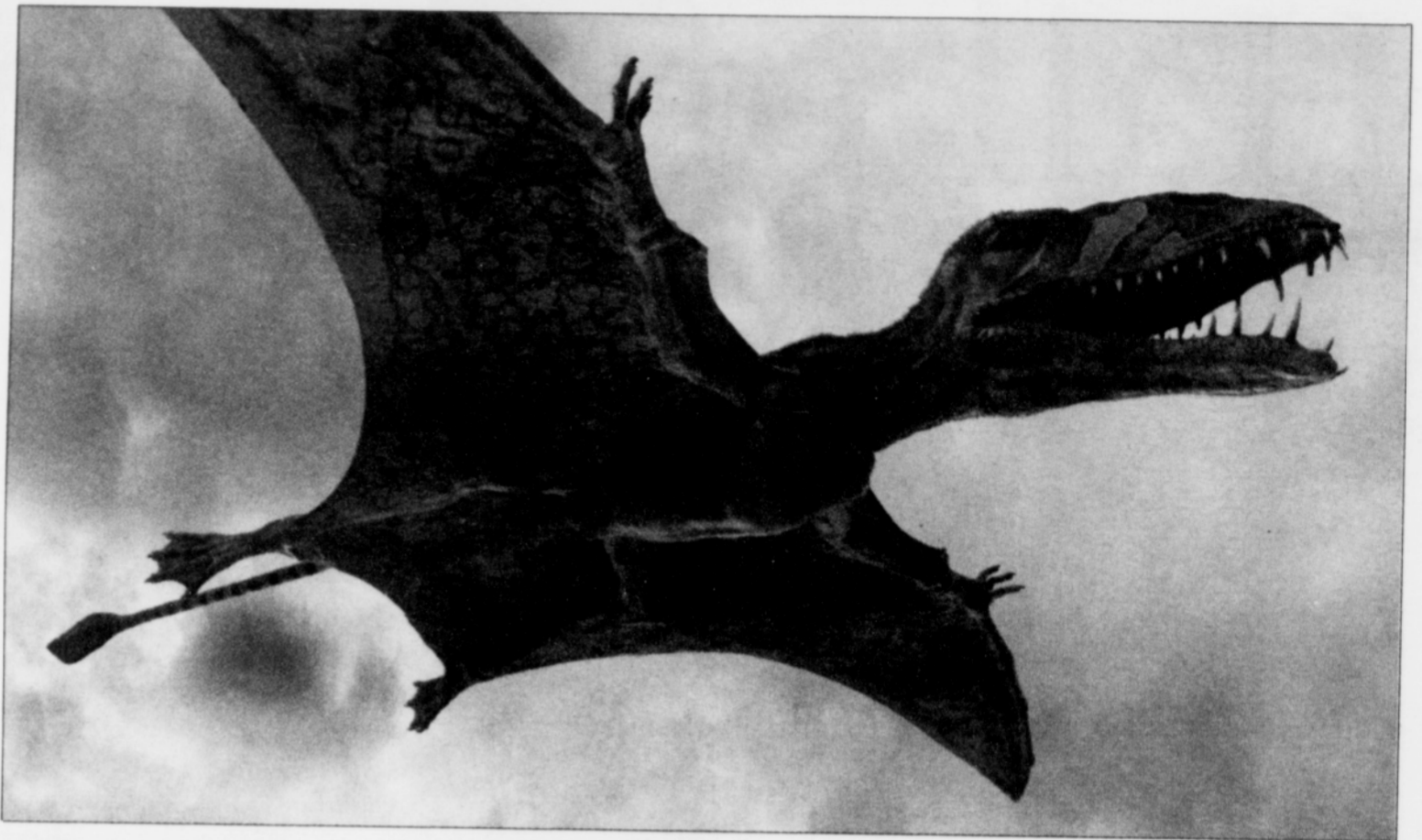

Herbie Hancock Portland Concert

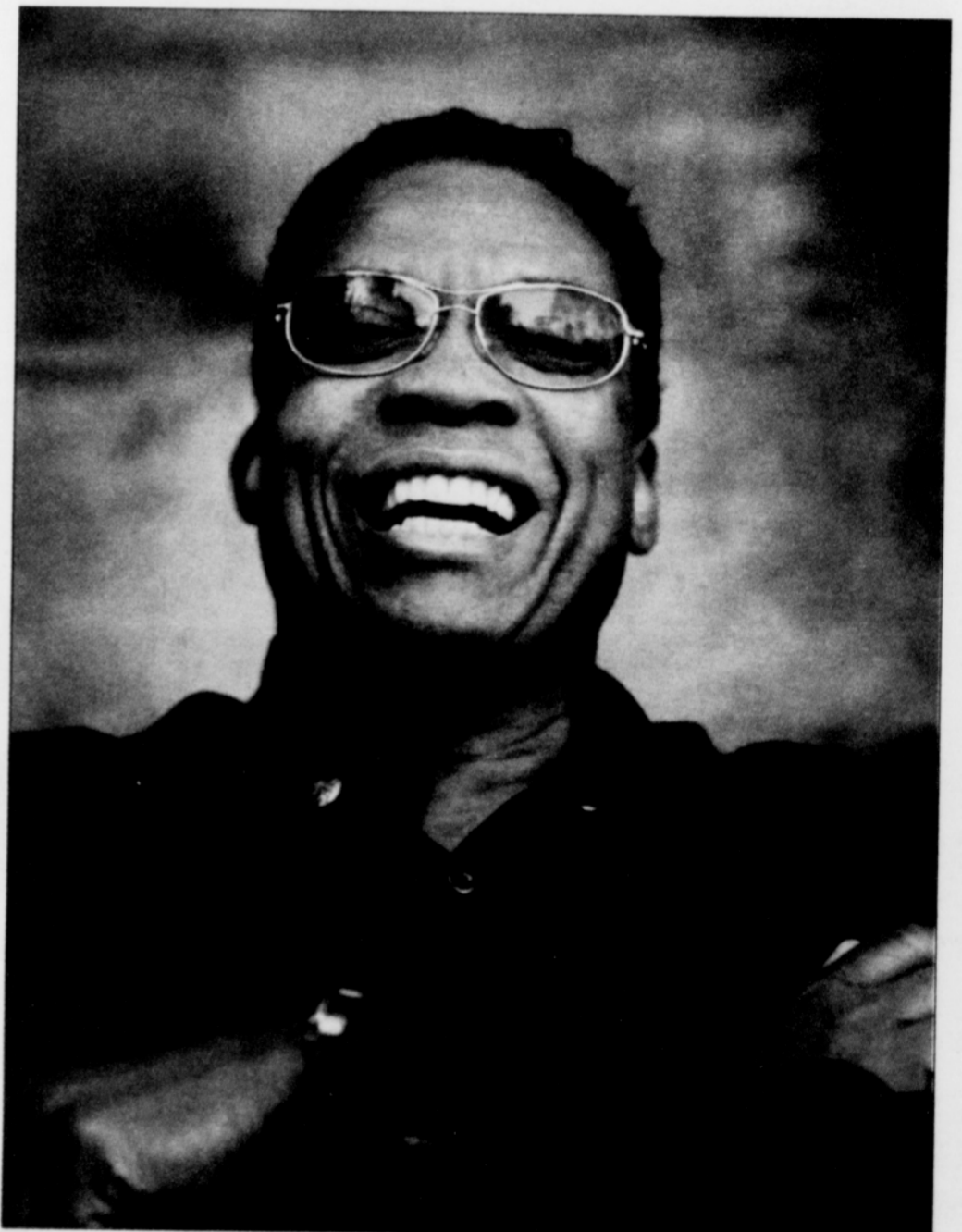
Legendary jazz artist to perform with Oregon Symphony

The legendary Herbie Hancock makes his Oregon Symphony debut with a program that includes his not-to-be-missed rendition of George Gershwin's "Rhapsody in Blue" and a number of Hancock's own compositions

The one performance show will take place Friday, Nov. 11 at 7:30 p.m. at the Arlene Schnitzer Concert Hall.

The 12-time Grammy Award winner is a true icon of modern music with an astonishing ability to transcend musical genres with his unmistakable musicality. No stranger to working with symphony orchestras, he played a Mozart piano concerto with the Chicago Symphony Orchestra when he was only 11. Today, he is the Creative Chair for Jazz with the Los Angeles Philharmonic Orchestra.
